

Emergency Procedures

Backboard Injury in Diving Well:

5-Foot Stand:

- Alert of the Emergency using the horn.
- Alert Staff of possible spinal injury
- Tell 3-Foot Guard to drop lane rope
- Enter pool and affect the rescue

3-Foot Stand:

- Clear the pool
- Alert someone to call 911
- Drop lane rope in the diving well when advised
- Assist 5-Foot guard in the rescue
- Tell someone to get backboard

Intermediate Pool:

- Clear Pool and stay on stand
- Ensure safety around the intermediate pool stand

Other Staff:

- Retrieve Backboard on command
- Aid lead guard in the rescue
- Ensure safety around pool while the rescue is taking place
- Open Back Gate to allow emergency vehicles to enter

- Alert 5-Foot guard of a possible spinal injury
- Enter pool and affect the rescue

Intermediate Pool:

- Clear Pool and stay on stand
- Ensure safety around the intermediate pool stand

Other Staff:

- Retrieve Backboard
- Aid lead guard in the rescue
- Ensure safety around pool while the rescue is taking place
- Open Back Gate to allow emergency vehicles to enter

Drowning Victim in 3-Foot End

5—Foot Stand:

- Clear the pool
- Ensure Safety around main pool
- Assist 3-Foot Guard (if necessary)
- Alert someone to call 911. (if necessary)

3-Foot Stand:

- Alert of the Emergency using the horn.
- Enter pool and affect the rescue

Intermediate Pool:

- Clear Pool and stay on stand
- Ensure safety around the intermediate pool stand

Other Staff:

- Aid lead guard in the rescue
- Ensure safety around pool while the rescue is taking place
- Open Back Gate if emergency rescue was called

Backboard victim in Intermediate pool:

5-Foot Guard:

- Clear the pool
- Ensure safety around main pool

3-Foot Guard:

- Assist Intermediate Pool Guard with rescue
- Alert someone to call 911
- Retrieve Backboard

Intermediate Pool Guard:

- Alert of the Emergency using the horn
- Alert to the staff of a spinal injury
- Call for backboard
- Enter pool and affect the rescue

Other Staff:

- Retrieve Backboard
- Aid lead guard in the rescue
- Ensure safety around pool while the rescue is taking place

Drowning victim in Intermediate Pool:

5-Foot Guard:

- Clear the pool
- Ensure safety around main pool

3-Foot Guard:

- Assist Intermediate Pool Guard with rescue
- Alert someone to call 911 (if necessary)

Intermediate Pool Guard:

- Alert of the Emergency using the horn
- Enter pool and affect the rescue

Other Staff:

- Aid lead guard in the rescue
- Ensure safety around pool while the rescue is taking place

Emergency in Baby Pool:

5-Foot Guard:

- Clear the pool
- Ensure safety around main pool

3-Foot Guard:

- Alert of the Emergency using the horn
- Shout if you require assistance
- Enter Baby pool area and affect the rescue

Intermediate Pool Guard:

- Clear the pool
- Ensure safety around main pool

Other Staff:

- Call 911
- Retrieve Backboard (if necessary)
- Aid lead guard in rescue
- Open Back Gate to allow emergency vehicles to enter
- Maintain safety in baby pool area (Very important)

Some Pointers:

- To ensure the health of the victim, effect rescue as quickly as possible.
- Stay Calm, if you are panicking, the victim will not feel safe and will panic further.
- If your job is to maintain the safety around a pool, do it. Do not look at the rescue taking place. We do not need two emergencies at once.
- If you hear the horn, stop whatever you are doing and assist in the rescue. The members will understand if are rude to them in order to help with a rescue.
- Stay alert on the stand. It is better to be a proactive than reactive.
